Objective

- The ILS course has been developed in order to standardise much of the in-hospital management of patients with cardiac arrest or peri arrest conditions.
- Its aim is to train healthcare personnel in cardiopulmonary resuscitation, simple airway management and safe defibrillation (manual and/or AED), enabling them to manage patients in cardiac arrest until arrival of a cardiac arrest team and to participate as members of that team.

Pre-course preparation

- The course is run over one day and consists of lectures and practical activities. The manual is forwarded two weeks before the start of the course and the candidate is advised to study this thoroughly.

- The ALS algorithm
